## Exciting things are happening at St. James

We have so graciously "received Christ Jesus our Lord" in our baptism. Last Sunday, we were a part of the journey of five confirmands as they pledged to 'continue their walk with Christ,' having been 'rooted and built up' as full persons in him. Their parents, grandparents, sponsors, and this church have supported them in their faith journey, and for their lives in Christ, we give thanks!

This year, we have seen life springing from every crevice of this community!

- We have baptized five children so far this year (with three more coming soon). We promised to support them as they grow with Christ.
- We have prayed for and lifted up seven new families who've answered the call to be disciples of Christ in this congregation and will be receiving more new members in October.
- We have welcomed two new staff members, building greater capacity for connection and tending the ground for new growth.

## An update on our strategic plan

In the midst of all this wonderful ministry, the leadership gathered, prayed, discussed, and made decisions regarding our strategic plan. The plan has been divided into two parts:

- The first part, our strategic values and vision, was crafted from scripture and placed into a beautiful new brochure that you can use to invite others to church.
- The second part, the objectives, was distributed on Sunday, September 28th, in preparation for our all-congregation **Town Hall Meeting on Sunday**, **October 5th**.

At this gathering, the leadership will share an overview of the process of building this strategic plan and the objectives that have been discerned since the LEAD team shared them with the council. Through all the listening and learning from one another, it became clear that our congregation needed avenues to support greater involvement. We opened ourselves to thinking strategically about the structure of our ministries.

In order to grow deeper in our relationships, there is a plan to have three branches of overarching ministry into which ministries fall:

- Jesus
- Congregation
- Neighborhood

To provide oversight, communication pathways, and connection, each of these branches will be co-led and work together to discern starter ideas and how we can all get involved to realize our vision for St. James. That's where you come in!
